

Green Event – 1st International Environmental Law Conference leads by example

The main focus of the event lies in sustainable protection of the earth as the basis of life for future generations. Every human being has an influence on environmental and climate protection. The International Conference On Environmental Law is aware of its responsibility and has dealt with the question that the event not only supports environment and climate in terms of its contents, but also prevents or reduces negative impacts in real life. As a consequence, the responsible parties have decided that the 1st International Environmental Law conference will be carbon-neutral.

E.ON Hanse AG as a supporter of 1st International Environmental Law conference in cooperation with KlimaINVEST Green Concepts GmbH, an agency for sustainability in Hamburg, have together developed a detailed carbon footprint for the 1st International Environmental Law conference.

Not only catering or event material and presentations have been included, but also accommodations as well as arrival and departure for all participants and speakers. The 1st International Environmental Law conference in cooperation with Deutsche Bahn request it's participants to travel in climate-friendly way to the conference.

The level of calculated CO₂-emissions of the conference is about 186 tons. They will be compensated through climate protection projects in accordance with the guidelines of the UN.

Thus, the 1st International Environmental Law conference will lead as a good example and it demonstrates that these simple but sophisticated operations can bring economy and ecology together.


The principle of climate neutrality is based on the idea of climate balance.

Greenhouse gases have a damaging global impact - and for climate protection it is irrelevant where they emerge or where they are avoided. Therefore, unavoidable emissions of greenhouse gases which are produced at location A can be neutralized through climate protection activities at location B.

It can be realized e.g. through constructing and operating a wind park instead of a coal-fired power plant. Due to the feed-in of energy generated by renewable sources in the grid the proportion of conventional generated energy (CO₂-non-neutral) will be decreased and greenhouse gases will be reduced. These reductions will be certified in the form of rights – one right of reduced CO₂-emissions stands for one saved tone of greenhouse gas emissions.


